As a member of the Ministry's Road Safety Education Network (RSEN) under the Public Outreach and Education Office (POEO), I've contributed to expand the educational and awareness efforts. I've also participated as a panellist, moderator, and expert at road safety and transportation events and supported Public Service Announcements (PSAs) to promote safer road behaviours.</p>
