



Impaired Driving Arrests (2016)


366 officers on the front line made 404 arrests


- Top 10 (3%) made 25% of the arrests
- Top 37 (10%) made 53% of the arrests
- 207 of 366 had zero impaired arrests
- Median number for everyone was 2 arrests

But, If everyone did the median (2 x arrests)



Roadside Testing 110% increase


