

BikeMaps.org Filling in safety data gaps with citizen science

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Data Needed!

- Cycling safety data are limited
- Official collision data with motor vehicles
 - Less than 30% reported
 - Not available quickly
 - Quality varies WIDELY between jurisdictions
 - Sometimes not available at all
- Hospital Emergency Room data (falls, collisions with non-vehicles) not related to locations
- No near miss reporting






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


Determining Hot Spots
